At Warren Wood Primary School, our Religious Education (RE) curriculum is designed to promote pupils' spiritual, moral, social, cultural and intellectual development through the exploration of religions and worldviews. Through a broad and balanced curriculum, pupils are supported to understand beliefs, values and traditions, while developing respect and empathy for others in an increasingly diverse society.

We are committed to providing an inclusive and enquiry-based approach to RE, where pupils are encouraged to explore and respond to questions of belief, meaning and purpose. Our curriculum reflects the principles of the NATRE framework and ensures that pupils engage with a range of religions and worldviews in a balanced way, without promoting or undermining any particular stance.

Through high-quality teaching, we develop the following essential characteristics in our pupils:

- An understanding of a range of religions and worldviews, including their beliefs, practices and traditions;
- The ability to express ideas, insights and personal responses to questions of belief and meaning;
- Respect for diversity and an appreciation of different perspectives within society;
- Critical thinking skills to explore and analyse religious and ethical questions;
- The ability to engage thoughtfully and sensitively in discussions about religion and human experience;
- Increased awareness of spiritual, moral, social and cultural issues;
- Confidence in communicating their understanding in a variety of ways.

Our RE curriculum is underpinned by the NATRE guidance and supports pupils to develop as reflective, respectful and informed individuals. It also aligns with our wider commitment to inclusion, so that everyone can access learning and develop their understanding at an appropriate level.
